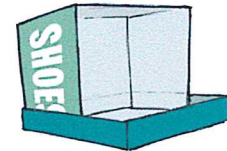
(If you are able to bring in extra supplies, either in the beginning of the year or through out the year, that would be greatly appreciated.)



Dear Parents,

School is out and summer is here. I hope you are planning to get away and enjoy some family time together with your children. Although summer is a time to take a break from school, it is still important for your children to keep up with their reading. I hope many of you have signed your kids up in the summer reading programs at your library. I am also assigning three books to be read over the summer and turned in on the first days of school. They will also have to do a project on two of the books. One project will be a diorama and the other a mobile. In case you are not sure of exactly what this entails I will define it for you.

1. **The Diorama:** The children will have to make a scene from the story inside a shoebox. The shoebox should be placed on its side and then the kids can use paper, clay, material, etc. to create a scene from the story.



2. **The Mobile:** The children draw pictures of the characters, the beginning, middle, and the end of the story, and then hang them from a hanger or sticks crisscrossed.



The following three books to read are required reading for the summer.

1. Arthur Meets the President by Marc Brown
2. The Giving Tree by Shel Silverstein
3. Freckle Juice by Judy Blume

There are many books out there for your child's grade level. I strongly recommend that you encourage your children to keep reading through the summer.
