Select one of the assignments below:

1. **Letter to a Character** – Write a letter (10 sentence minimum) to the main character of the book asking questions, protesting a situation, and/or making a complaint/suggestion. This must be done in the correct letter format. Mount it on large construction paper or make a poster for it.
2. **Comic Book** – Create a mini comic book relating a chapter of the book complete with comic style illustrations and dialogue bubbles.
3. **Ten Facts** – create a “Ten Facts About [book title]” poster that lists ten facts you learned from reading the book. Ten facts, written in complete sentences and illustrated, must include details you didn’t know before reading the book.

Assignments will be due on the first full day of school in which your literature class is meeting. It will be graded as a test grade for the 1st Marking Period
